



SECURITY SYSTEM

The three components of the Globix facility security program are a comprehensive state-of-the-art access-control system, trained security personnel and closed-circuit television cameras (CCTV). The Globix security system is a distributed-control system with central monitoring located in the Security Dispatch Center. The use of such a system prevents tampering at any given point in the system without at least one other system being aware of the tamper.

The security system uses a series of perimeter challenges for entry into the facility. All primary entry and egress points are stationed with access-card readers. Entry to all data center and data center support areas requires finger biometric access as well as a valid access badge. All doors are monitored by CCTV and equipped with alarms for tamper protection. The system is programmed to deal proactively with entry violations. For example, if an access badge is not swiped at the exit, it will not permit re-entry.

In addition to Globix security personnel that monitor the Security Dispatch Center 24 hours a day, roving security personnel patrol the premises constantly. All Globix security personnel and data center staff have undergone background checks performed by a third-party firm, and all receive training to guard against incursions of Globix property. The CCTV system records and monitors activity both inside and outside the Globix facility. All activities at entry and egress points to the data center are taped, as is the data center itself.
